1. Shall there be a convention to amend the constitution?

2. Are you in favor of amending the Constitution to provide that the Secretary of State shall lay the votes for Governor before the senate and house of representatives on the first Wednesday following the first Tuesday of January?

(Passed by the N.H. House, 283 Yes 1 No, passed State Senate, 20 Yes 0

(Questions proposed by the 1981 Legislature)
