After the Primary, twelve requests for recounts were received.

Eight requests were Republican and four requests were Democratic. Two recounts of ballots cast—Hillsborough County Sheriff, Democratic and Representative in Congress, District No. 1, Republican, were conceded by Albert Lambert and Robert C. Smith, respectively, before the completion of the recount.

The result of the Primary Election in Senate District No. 16 was a tie. Lots were drawn and Frank A. Wageman was declared the winner. A recount was requested, which resulted in a win for Eleanor P. Podles.

The other recounts did not result in a change of nominees.
