## PRESIDENTIAL PRIMARY, 1976

A Presidential Primary was held February 24, 1976 for the choice of delegates to the national conventions.

The Republican party elected fifteen delegates at large and fifteen alternate delegates at large; also three delegates from each of the two Congressional Districts and the same number of alternate delegates from each District.

The Democratic party elected nine delegates from the First Congressional District and nine alternate delegates; and eight delegates from the Second Congressional District and eight alternate delegates.

The following summary tables show the names of the candidates for delegates at large, their alternates; district delegates and their alternates; with the number of votes for each; also the person, if any, to whom each was favorable or pledged.
